

# Sanyo ICR – A190M Digital Voice Recorder



This is a simple to operate Digital Voice Recorder that enables the user to record sounds in an mp3 format. Files stored on the Voice Recorder can then be edited using Audacity or displayed on a web page (i.e. “Making the News.”)

## Using the Sanyo ICR Digital Voice Recorder – Quick Start Instructions

### Recording a Message

- Slide the POWER/HOLD key down to the “on position.”
- Press the FOLDER/REPEAT key to select one of the five folders A,B,C,D or Music
- Press the REC key down to commence recording
- To end recording press the STOP/MENU key
- *The counter in that folder will have increased by 1*

### To Playback a Recording

- Select the folder that contains the recording by pressing the FOLDER / REPEAT key
- To find the correct in that folder press the SKIP / SEARCH key
- To playback the recording press the PLAY button

### To erase a Recording

- Select and display the recording you wish to Erase
- Press Erase once to confirm selection
- Now press the Erase button for a further 2 seconds to permanently delete the file

### Transferring files to a PC

- Connect the USB cable from the Recorder to the PC
- The computer will recognise that a New Hardware device has been attached
- Open folder to view files using Windows Explorer. Three files DATA, MUSIC and VOICE will be displayed
- Click on voice to open FOLDERS A, B, C and D
- Select and click to open the appropriate folder
- Right click on the file/s to be transferred to your PC
- Now Copy / Move the files to another folder on your PC
